## **GEORGIA TECH PRIORITIES**

» Secure \$1.62 million to expand startup incubator ATDC

Second year of a two-year expansion project, funding would provide additional professional coaching staff to support creation of new start-up companies in Georgia.

» Strengthen partnership with Department of Agriculture and Georgia AgriTech Innovation Initiative

Building partnerships to pursue and solve grand challenges in agriculture and to position Georgia as the leader in cuttingedge research, technology development and education.

## **UNIVERSITY SYSTEM PRIORITIES**

» Secure renewal of the provision allowing carryforward of certain USG funds

Under this provision, USG institutions can carry a small amount of funds from one fiscal year to the next, allowing for better planning and allocation of resources.

» Secure \$54.45 million in new Formula Funds to be shared among all USG institutions

Funding supports critical day-to-day operations and is essential to maintaining academic quality.

» Secure \$60 million in Major Repair and Rehabilitation Funds to repair aging facilities across the System

Georgia Tech's allocation will be directed toward more than \$100 million in deferred maintenance needs.
